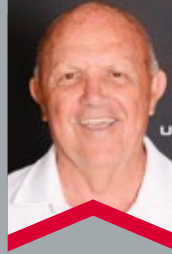
PHILOSOPHY

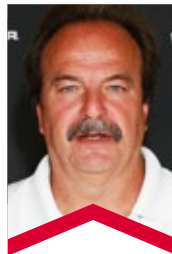
